General Event Info:

Back Gate Opens at 12 noon. All must unload. No truck/trailer/personal vehicles in pits on race day.

Pit Passes: \$40 driver/\$30 crew (Note: WVSO allows 14yo into pits, but must have signed waiver by parents AND copy of birth certificate.)

NO TRACK OR SERIES MEMBERSHIP FEE IS REQUIRED. Open to all LM cars meeting LMCS rules.

LMCS event registration/tech fee: \$40/car

Hot Lap sessions for LMs begin at 3pm (tentative). All cars must pass tech and scales prior to hot lapping. Three practice sessions: 45/30/15 minutes. Qualifying

for all classes begin at 6pm. Racing begins at 7:00pm.

Format: A & B trophy dashes, B-main, hot lap session, 150-lap Feature Event.

Feature Event: 18 cars locked into feature by qualifying. 4 additional move up from B, plus 2 provisional positions. (24 car max.)

Front Gate Opens at 5:00pm. Ticket Prices: \$14.00 adult / \$9.50 student (13-17) / \$5.00 kids (6-12)

Tires will be available in advance of race date and will be available for purchase at the racetracks on race days. Tire mounting will be available. The series reserves the right to implement a limit on the number of tires each team can purchase per event.

TIRE RULE - Cars must start the feature on the same tires they qualified. Cars that run in the last chance race may change tires prior to that race, but must return to the qualifying tires for the feature. No altering of tire or tire softening chemicals allowed.
