Late Model Challenge Series Moves to Stateline Speedway

Graham, WA (June 1, 2006): On Saturday June 3, the best Late Model Stock Car racers in the Northwest come to Stateline Stadium & Speedway's .25-Mile Oval in Post Falls, ID. Race number three for the traveling Late Model Challenge Series has an expected 30 cars for the Inland Northwest Consultants 100. All are up to the challenge of Idaho's premier racing complex.

No one has repeated as a winner in 2006. Troy Conrad won on the .25-mile at Wenatchee, WA and BJ Tidrick on the .50-mile at Yakima, WA. Qualifying well at Stateline will be very important with such a large field of drivers expected for this event. With the top 16-qualifiers locked into the Inland Northwest Consultants 100. Two more are added via provisional using last seasons final point standings and the final four positions for the 22-car starting grid come from the top four finishers of the Last Chance Main. After the first two 2006 opening race qualifying sessions the difference between the top qualifier and the last to lock into the main has been less than 6/10 of a second.

Local drivers expected to compete are Kevin Richards, Mark Oergal, Andy Brown, Dave Garber and Shelby Thompson all from Spokane, WA. Other notable drivers expected are Mark Owens and Alex Lessor of Kalispell, MT, Troy Conrad of Tacoma, WA, Mike

Zamora of Kennewick, WA, Bryon Harvey and Willy Thom from Oregon and Ryan Fischer of Surrey, B.C. The Series has drivers representing Oregon, Washington, Idaho, Montana and British Columbia, Canada.
